SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT SERVICES

Our Substance Abuse Treatment Services are comprehensive and holistic services designed to meet the diverse needs of the adolescent and adult populations. Services are client focused, recovery driven, and vary in intensity depending on individual need. We take an integrated approach to mental health and substance abuse treatment, and actively work to treat the whole person in all aspects of health and wellbeing. And we address complex co-occurring problems related to substance abuse including grief, anxiety, depression, PTSD, and the experiencing or witnessing of all types of trauma.



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Adolescent and Adult Treatment Modalities

- Level 0.5 Early Intervention: Education services targeting those individuals who are at risk for developing substance abuse problems.
- Level I Outpatient: Treatment services for the individual dealing with significant risk substance misuse at the abuse level. Treatment consists of individual, group, and family counseling.
- Level II Intensive Outpatient Treatment: Treatment services for the individual dealing with high risk substance misuse at the dependent level. Treatment consists of individual, group, and family counseling; and is a minimum of nine hours per week.
